Educational Objectives

CPC 200 is a powerboat handling immersion course designed specifically for those who wish to improve their close quarters maneuvering skills. This 12 hour, hands on program is conducted on board a Chapman School training vessel of up to 32 feet*. Taught by professional U.S.C.G. licensed captains utilizing Chapman's proven "Learn at the Helm"TM method of teaching, the skills learned are fundamental requirements for the competent boater.

Designed as a stand alone program, the successful completion of CPC 200 earns the student certification on either a twin or single inboard vessel or an outboard/stern drive vessel. This valuable program is highly regarded by experienced and novice boaters alike.

Course Description

This 2 day class includes 12 hours of underway instruction on either a:

- Single or twin inboard vessel
- Outboard or I/O

This course begins dockside with vessel orientation and pre-departure inspection followed by the close quarters maneuvering practice of:

- Docking and undocking in a protected slip, bow and stern first
- 360° turns in tight quarters
- Coming alongside a facing pier (such as a fuel dock) both port and starboard
- Backing down 100 yards in a narrow channel

Course Description (cont'd)

- Docking bow and stern first with only one engine operable
- Docking and undocking using spring lines.

Instructors will also cover:

- Refueling safety procedures
- Proper use of VHF marine radio
- Navigational Aids and Basic Rules of the Road.

**For training on vessels 33 feet and larger, please contact the Registrar for specific pricing and availability.*

Note: Should you be the only student in the class requesting a particular vessel type, such as I/O, you will receive private, hands-on underway instruction on a six hour schedule.

Admission Requirements

- Minimum student age is 15.
- Submission of Registration Form completed and signed (by a parent/guardian if under 18), and non-refundable deposit.
- Provide official photo ID on the first day of class.
- Class requires a minimum of three (3) students.

Testing and Certification

Students who successfully pass a boat handling skills test given at the conclusion of the program will be awarded a "Certificate of Completion" from the Chapman School of Seamanship.

This certificate may also qualify a boat owner for marine insurance discounts.

- Non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 due with completed Registration Form.
- Tuition balance due 10 days prior to the start of class.
- Tuition includes all books, supplies and laboratory fees.
- Tuition does not include housing or transportation.
- All costs are payable in U.S. currency only.
- School accepts all major credit cards.

Transfer/Refund Policy

- If Registration not accepted by the School, all payments will be fully refunded.
- Where notice is provided to School more than 3 business days before the start of class to transfer registration to a different class, a \$50.00 change fee will apply.
- Where notice is provided to School more than 3 business days before start of class to cancel registration, applicant will be obligated for the non-refundable tuition deposit.
- Where notice is provided to School less than 3 business days before start of class to transfer or cancel registration; or if the applicant does not arrive for the scheduled class; or if the applicant withdraws from class once classes have begun, applicant may be obligated for the full amount of the tuition.
- Applicable refunds are made within thirty (30) days.

Student Housing

- Apartments have a bedroom, convertible living room/bedroom, kitchen, bathroom, and covered porch. Apartments are air-conditioned, furnished, and equipped with counter top range, refrigerator, and cooking utensils.
- Number of students per apartment is generally a maximum of two.
- Housing is offered on a space available basis.
- School is not responsible for loss of any personal property. Sorry, no pets.

Housing Fees

Housing Fee.... \$60.00(per night)

- For a second or third person in a party add \$20 per night/per person
- Housing includes utilities.
- Housing fees are due 10 days prior to the start of class.

Housing Refund

- If a student cancels prior to the start of class, housing fees will be refunded.
- Once a student moves into the facilities no fees will be refunded.
- In the event of damage to the accommodations, the student will be responsible for all costs required to repair the damaged school property.
- Applicable refunds are made within thirty (30) days.

Travel Considerations

If travelling to the School from outside of Florida we strongly suggest you purchase refundable air fares or arrange for trip cancellation insurance.

Notes:

Each student is required to furnish his or her own deck shoes.
