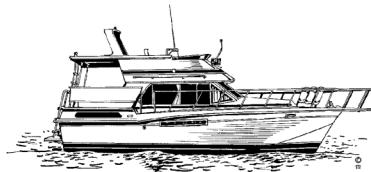


## Just for You

#### Your vessel up to 39'

(4 hrs minimum/plus travel expenses\*)

One person (4 hour day)	\$400
Additional persons (per person)	\$200

One person (6 hour day)	\$600
Additional persons (per person)	\$300

#### Your vessel 40' - 60'

(4 hrs minimum/plus travel expenses\*)

One person (4 hour day)	\$600
Additional persons (per person)	\$300

One person (6 hour day)	\$900
Additional persons (per person)	\$450

\*Travel expense rate is \$30 per hour plus mileage.

\*Travel outside 100 miles from the School's location requires an overnight stay by the Captain. Per diem rates are set by <https://www.federalpay.org/perdiem>.

*Instruction on your vessel requires proof of insurance and safety equipment requirements. Contact us for details.*

The fee for each program includes a two hundred dollar (\$200) non-refundable tuition deposit.

## Certification

A Chapman School certificate of completion is awarded to students who complete the course. These certificates may qualify a boat owner for marine insurance discounts.

## Admission

Persons attending this program must submit paperwork and fees and be in good health. The student must have an official photo ID on the first day of class.

- The Registration Form must be completed and signed (by a parent or guardian if the applicant is under 18) and returned to the School along with the \$200 non-refundable deposit.
- Tuition balance is due in full 10 days prior to the start of class.
- Tuition includes books, supplies and laboratory fees.
- Tuition does not include housing, board or transportation.
- All costs are payable in U.S. currency only.

## Credit Cards

If you have a Discover, Visa or MasterCard credit card you may use your credit card to pay for School fees.

**Each student is required to furnish his or her own deck shoes.**

*The School does not discriminate on the basis of age, sex, religion, race or ethnic origin in the administration of its policies & programs.*

## Refund Policy

- If the application is not accepted by the School, all payments made by the applicant will be refunded.
- If cancellation is requested within three (3) business days after signing the Registration Form, all payments made by the applicant will be refunded.
- If cancellation is requested more than three (3) business days after signing the Registration Form, but before the beginning of instruction, the applicant is obligated for \$200 which may be applied to a future boating course within one year.
- For the student terminating training after the beginning of the course, the student is obligated for the full amount of the contract price.
- Applicable refunds are made within thirty (30) days.

## Student Housing

Student housing consists of dormitory apartments. Each unit contains a bedroom, convertible living room/bedroom, bath, kitchenette and a covered porch. The number of students per unit during this program is generally a maximum of two. All units are furnished and equipped with refrigerator, counter top range and cooking utensils. Housing is offered on a space available basis. The School is not responsible for the loss of any personal property. Sorry, no pets.

## Housing Fees

- Housing Fee . . . . . \$60.00 (per night)
- For a second or third person in a party add \$20 per night/person.
- Housing includes utilities.

## Housing Refund

- Housing fees are due 10 days prior to the start of class to reserve accommodations.
- If a student cannot attend the classes for which he/she is registered, housing fees are refundable.
- Once a student moves into the unit, no fees will be refunded .
- In the event any student does damage to the accommodations, he or she will be responsible for the replacement cost and labor required to repair the damaged School property.

Fees and information described are subject to change without notice at the discretion of the Chapman School of Seamanship. Currently enrolled students will not be affected by such changes unless they change the date of enrollment to a future date.
