

Chapman School of Seamanship offers the STCW “Standards for Training, Certification & Watch-keeping” training endorsements described below which enable mariners to move from deck hands to deck officers.

### **Basic Training**

This **5 day course** covers the four modules required for Coast Guard approved endorsement. These modules include Personal Safety/Social Responsibilities, Personal Survival Techniques, Elementary First Aid and Basic Marine Firefighting.

**Firefighting will be held at Port Canaveral Maritime Academy.**

### **Basic Training Renewal**

This 3 day renewal course will satisfy requirements set forth by the USCG. For course dates contact Registrar.

### **Combined Basic Advanced Firefighting**

This **5 day course** consists of classroom lectures, instructor demonstrations and hands-on training for subjects related to shipboard firefighting. Students will learn:

- Fire chemistry classification
- Fire prevention
- Use of portable extinguishers, breathing apparatus, protective clothing and foam application
- Confined space, open deck and multilevel firefighting
- Effects on ship stability
- Team training
- Incident Command System “ICS”
- Shore-based fire fighting coordination
- Dealing with hazardous materials

### **Combined Basic Advanced Firefighting (cont’d)**

Students spend a large portion of their training time fighting basic and complex live fires on board a land-based vessel. This course meets STCW-95 requirements for both lower and upper level licenses.

### **Maritime Security Awareness**

Provides knowledge for crew members working at port facilities & on vessels. Includes the meaning & requirements for the different security levels; emergency procedures & contingency plans; recognition & detection of weapons, dangerous substances and devices; non-discriminatory recognition of the characteristics & behavioral patterns of persons likely to threaten security and the techniques used to circumvent security measures.

### **Able Seaman Offshore Supply Vessel “OSV”- 40hrs.**

The AB - OSV **5 day course** covers the necessary United States Coast Guard “USCG” Deck General, Navigation General and Deck Safety Rules of the Road. The course also includes hands on training, tying various knots, splices, bends and hitches with students being required to demonstrate their ability to complete a number of them within 15- minute increments.

Preparation and USCG testing is included and the certification is advantageous for those students seeking to explore work opportunities in the Commercial segment of Maritime Industry.

### **ADMISSION**

The successful student must have solid English and math skills. In addition, the student must be 18 years of age, (have basic swimming skills for BT) and be in good health. Students must submit a signed Registration Form and have an official photo ID on the first day of class.

### Transfer/Refund Policy

- If Registration not accepted by the School, all payments will be fully refunded.
- Where notice is provided to School more than 3 business days before the start of class to transfer registration to a different class, a \$50.00 change fee will apply.
- Where notice is provided to School more than 3 business days before start of class to cancel registration, applicant will be obligated for the non-refundable tuition deposit.
- Where notice is provided to School less than 3 business days before start of class to transfer or cancel registration; or if the applicant does not arrive for the scheduled class; or if the applicant withdraws from class once classes have begun, applicant may be obligated for the full amount of the tuition.

### Student Housing

- Apartments have a bedroom, convertible living room/ bedroom, kitchen, bathroom, and covered porch. Apartments are air-conditioned, furnished, and equipped with counter top range, refrigerator and cooking utensils.
- Number of students per apartment is generally a maximum of two.
- Housing is offered on a space available basis.
- School is not responsible for loss of any personal property. Sorry, no pets.

### Housing Fees

- Housing Fee.... \$70.00(per night)
- For a second or third person. in a party add \$20 per night/ per person.
  - Housing includes utilities.
  - Housing fees are due 10 days prior to the start of class.

### Housing Refund

- If a student cancels prior to the start of class, housing fees will be refunded.
- Once a student moves into the facilities no housing fees will be refunded.
- If a credit card was used as the original method of payment, a convenience fee of 3.0% of the total amount refunded will apply for all transactions.
- In the event of damage to the accommodations, the student will be responsible for all costs required to repair the damaged school property.
- Applicable refunds are made within thirty (30) days.

### Travel Considerations

If travelling to the School from outside of Florida we strongly suggest you purchase refundable air fares or arrange for trip cancellation insurance.

The school has the right to cancel the program of training up to 10 days prior to the start of class due to insufficient enrollment.
