

## Private Lessons

### Just for you....

Chapman School of Seamanship is pleased to offer private boat handling Instruction on board your vessel on Cape Cod. All instruction will be developed to meet your specific boat handling objectives and will be taught by licensed USCG Captains/Chapman School of Seamanship Instructors.



Instruction can be one-on-one or up to five (5) students depending on the size of your vessel.

#### Training will include:

- A Pre-planning telephone or e-mail interview to determine your specific training objectives.
- A daily syllabus developed prior to the start of training.
- Itinerary of training area
- Cost estimate
- Instruction can run from a minimum of 4 hours to any length of time as per your requirements.

#### You will need to provide:

- A seaworthy vessel for the intended area of instruction.
- Dockage for any overnight or out of area voyages
- All vessel operational costs, i.e. gas, equipment, parts, etc
- Charts for area of operations
- Guide books
- An insurance binder stating coverage for the Captain/Crew for the duration of the instruction.

#### Instruction

Training will be customized for you and can include:

- Boat handling: undocking/docking; line handling; communications; close quarter maneuvering
- Navigation
- Rules of the road
- Piloting
- Electronic navigation
- Planning a short or long voyage
- Safety and equipment
- Weather considerations
- General risk assessment

Depending on where you are located on the Cape, voyages can be:

**All voyages are dependent on Weather, Visibility and Sea State.**

#### Rates are as follows:

- Instructor rate at \$90.00 per hour for one or two people. (For 6 or more hours of instruction a 10% discount will apply).
- Travel time to and from Sandwich/Sagamore to your location at \$50.00 per hour, plus 55.0 cents per mile.
- Development time; depending on the extent of your training request at \$45.00 per hour (this will be estimated after initial phone or email interview)
- Lodging for overnight voyages
- Food per-diem for overnight voyages or meals provided by client
- Non-refundable tuition deposit of \$200.00 required with registration form.
